The Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) degree with direct supervised clinical rotations experience offers something that no other institution school offers. Our students can select their elective courses to build a truly unique. It fosters the in-depth understanding you'll need to rise to the top of the nursing profession. You will complete your custom program with a capstone experience that will tie all of the concepts together helping you apply your academic preparation during a practicum experience.

University Central of Ashdod's Master of Science in Nursing degree program can be completed in as little as 16 months to 23 months. The graduate program consists of 48 graduate credits. Electives can be taken concurrently with core nursing courses. Courses generally run eight weeks in duration and are taken one at a time. This unique approach allows students to become fully immersed in the subject matter of each course.

The student has the option to earn a Master of Science in Nursing in Administration or Master of Science in Nursing with specialization in adult nursing. The latter allows the student to apply for a seat in the National Board for Nursing Practitioner.

In accordance with The Essentials of Master's Education for Advanced Practice Nursing of the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN), 1996, the faculty identified the following expected outcomes of each student at the end of the MSN program in nursing: Upon successful completion of the program leading to the MSN degree, all graduates will have acquired the ability to:

- o Integrate research in practice settings as a basis for clinical and organization decision making;
- o Operationalize quality, cost effective nursing practice principles and function as a leader and advocate of health care policy, organization and health care finance;
- o Collaboratively appraise ethical issues in health care as they affect individuals, communities, society, and the health professions;
- o Exercise ethical decision making from a personal and organizational perspective;
- o Integrate the advanced nursing role into professional practice while assuming personal responsibility for professional competencies and development;
- o Pursue doctoral education;
- o Evaluate, and utilize appropriate theory within an advanced nursing context; and
- o and incorporate respect for human diversity and dignity while participating in culturally and spiritually sensitive practice and community service;
