

NUR – 2010 Nursing Ethics (3 Theory credits)

This course focuses on examination of ethical dimensions of professional nursing practice with exploration of applied nursing ethics, moral development, ethical theories and principles, and moral reasoning.

Teaching Methods:

Lecture, Guest Lecturers, Class Discussion, Values Clarification, Diary-Journal, internet component.

Textbook:

None required.

Students are required to explore articles and books of their choosing, and to self-select and read at least 2 sources listed under sections containing the words "Readings" or "Texts" on the course syllabus.
